## **Eligibility criteria for SIG National Scholarships**

Are you eligible for a SIG Scholarship? All categories	<ul> <li>Applicants for SIG Scholarships must meet all relevant eligibility requirements below.</li> <li>Complete the eligibility checklist before progressing.</li> <li>Are you a citizen of the Solomon Islands?</li> <li>Do you meet the minimum academic requirements for the Scholarship for which you are applying? (See Criteria)</li> <li>Are you applying for a course and field of study at an education institution that is included in the National Training Plan?</li> <li>Are you currently not holding another scholarship?</li> <li>Are you willing to return to the Solomon Islands for two years on completing your scholarship?</li> <li>Will you be committed to your studies while on scholarship?</li> <li>Are you competent in speaking and writing the language of instruction where you will be studying?</li> <li>Have you previously been terminated from a SIG Scholarship?</li> <li>Are you nead and understood the conditions of a SIG Scholarship?</li> </ul>
In-Service scholarship applicants only	<ul> <li>Are you currently employed?</li> <li>Do you have the support of your employer to take up a scholarship?</li> <li>Will your study choice better equip you to undertake your work on completion of your studies?</li> </ul>
Age limits for applicants	<ul> <li>To apply for a SIG scholarship, you have meet the following age requirements:</li> <li>For Certificate, Diploma and Bachelor's Degree</li> <li>Pre-Service Scholarships - 35 years of age and under</li> <li>In-Service Teacher's scholarship – 45 years of age and under</li> <li>In-Service Public Sector Scholarship - 45 years of age and under</li> </ul>

	For Masters and PhD
	<ul> <li>Master's degree - 50 years of age and under</li> <li>PhD – limited restriction</li> </ul>
Constituency Development Scholarship Applicants	<ul> <li>To uphold the integrity of SIG Scholarships, Constituency Scholarship applicants must meet all the following Eligibility Criteria to receive a scholarship:</li> <li>Is a member of the MP's constituency</li> <li>Is a citizen of the Solomon Islands</li> <li>Is not an MP's 'associate' as defined by the Leadership Code</li> <li>Does not have a criminal record and does not have any outstanding law enforcement matters</li> <li>Must select a course and education institution identified in the Solomon Island Tertiary and Skills Education Training Plan for that year.</li> <li>Must meet the SIG Scholarships GPA and have achieved the required GPA for the identified program of study.</li> <li>If currently a self-sponsored student, must submit academic transcripts (two semesters or have successfully completed a minimum of 8 units) for this study to show that they are making satisfactory academic progress including a confirmation letter of no outstanding dues from the institution of study</li> <li>Has not previously held a scholarship (SIG Scholarship or other scholarship) for tertiary studies within the past two years.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Has not had a SIG Scholarship terminated.</li> <li>Applicants should be applying only for Pre-Service Scholarship categories</li> <li>Applicant to submit application online.</li> </ul>
